SUBJECT: 2020-2021 Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program Selection

The Florida Department of Agriculture and Consumer Services (FDACS) Division of Food, Nutrition and Wellness (FNW) would like to thank all sponsors for applying for the 2020-2021 Fresh Fruit and Vegetable Program (FFVP). Application to participate in the program indicates that schools are making efforts to combat childhood obesity by helping students learn more healthful eating habits.

The attached document shows the award amounts available to each of the selected schools for the 2020-2021 school year. FFVP funding is allotted for use July 1, 2020 through June 30, 2021. The level of funding provided to each awarded school is \$65 per student of total enrollment based upon October 2019 reported data. **Keep in mind, FFVP funds cannot be moved from one school to another at any time during the FFVP year.**

Please be aware that this is a federally funded program and any funds that are not spent will be returned to USDA. FFVP funds are highly sought, often over 400 schools apply each year. When selecting awardees FNW takes into consideration the FFVP fund balances from the past three years. Please make every effort to spend all available funds, and as always, contact FNW if assistance is needed.

Agreement/Addendum

Within two weeks, FNW will provide two original copies of the Addendum to the Sponsor Agreement with FDACS to participate in the USDA FFVP as authorized by The Food, Conservation and Energy Act of 2008 (Farm Bill). Both copies of the Addendum require the **original signature in blue ink** of your Chief Administrator. When the Agreement/Addendum is fully executed, a copy will be returned.
