PRICE INCREASE / DECREASE EXPLANATION:

Due to increased lead times on parts and equipment the amount needs to be increased to variable. In order to keep schools operating we often have to rent equipment until the issue can be resolved, either by repair or replacement.

DISCUSSION:

Pricing is based on The City of Palm Bay, IFB #45-0-2020, Equipment Rental (Co-op)

State Board of Education Rule 6A-1.012(6) allows school districts to make purchases at or below the specified prices from contracts awarded by other city or county governmental agencies, other district school boards, community colleges, federal agencies, the public or governmental agencies of any state, or from state university system cooperative bid agreements, when the proposer awarded a contract by another entity will permit purchases by a district school board at the same terms, conditions, and prices (or below such prices) awarded in such contract, and such purchases are to the economic advantage of the district school board.

The standard piggyback agreement template was previously used, which did not require legal review.

CONTRACT TERM:

The initial contract commenced on October 7, 2020 and will continue until August 31, 2023 with two (2) optional one (1) year renewal periods.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the recommendation of Susan Hann, Assistant Superintendent of Facilities Services and James Ross, Director of Plant Operations and Maintenance to increase the award amount from \$50,000.00 to Variable on the Equipment Rental (Co-Op) piggyback agreement.
