DISCUSSION:

A Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued for a Staff Evaluation and Professional Management System on November 10, 2021, with proposals due on December 14, 2021. There was a total of 34 plan holders. Two responses were received. It has been determined to be in the best interest of the School Board to reject all responses and issue a new solicitation with revised specifications.

The RFP schedule was initially set up to allow time to implement a new system for SY23. After the selection process was completed, it was decided implementation would be pushed back to SY24 because of other new systems being introduced in SY23, SIS and substitute management. Contract negotiations were delayed because of this decision and due to prioritization of projects. Once resumed, contract negotiations were unsuccessful in establishing sufficient accountability measures for vendor performance. This was a major concern based on performance of the current contract with the same vendor.

In accordance with Florida Statute 119.071, (1) (b) 3. "the rejected bids, proposals, or replies remain exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution until such time as the agency provides notice of an intended decision concerning the reissued competitive solicitation or until the agency withdraws the reissued competitive solicitation. A bid, proposal, or reply is not exempt for longer than 12 months after the initial agency notice rejecting all bids, proposals, or replies."
