The initial contract term was Board approved on September 25, 2018 with an expiration date of June 30, 2020. Florida Department of Management Services has extended the term for an additional six (6) months through December 31, 2020.

State Board of Education Rule 6A-1.012 (5), the district school board shall receive and give consideration to the prices available to it under rules of the Department of Management Services, Division of Purchasing. District school boards may use prices established by the Division of Purchasing through its state purchasing agreement price schedule. If district school board policy provides for purchasing under this program of state purchasing agreements the conditions for use shall be those imposed on state agencies.

CONTRACT TERM:

The contract term shall be extended through December 31, 2020.
