DISCUSSION:

A Request for Proposal (RFP) was issued for Athletic Apparel Sponsorship on February 7, 2023, with proposals due on March 21, 2023. There was a total of 37 plan holders. Six responses were received, two of those were considered nonresponsive. It has been determined to be in the best interest of the School Board to reject all proposals with the intention to issue a revised competitive solicitation when timing is more favorable.

In accordance with Florida Statute 119.071, (1) (b) 3. "the rejected bids, proposals, or replies remain exempt from s. 119.07(1) and s. 24(a), Art. I of the State Constitution until such time as the agency provides notice of an intended decision concerning the reissued competitive solicitation or until the agency withdraws the reissued competitive solicitation. A bid, proposal, or reply is not exempt for longer than 12 months after the initial agency notice rejecting all bids, proposals, or replies."
