PRICE INCREASE / DECREASE EXPLANATION: We anticipate a 20% growth based on the previous year’s enrollment.

DISCUSSION:

The Cambridge AICE (Advanced International Certificate in Education) Program is part of the University of Cambridge based in Cambridge, England, and serves schools in over 160 countries. Students who receive an E or higher are awarded postsecondary credit. Each AICE exam passed with an E or higher earns .16 FTE, and each student who earns an AICE Diploma earns an extra .3 FTE. FTE money from 2021-2022 Cambridge Programs totals \$2,155,825.00. Eau Gallie High, Heritage High, and Rockledge High offer the AICE (Cambridge) Diploma. Johnson Middle, Kennedy Middle and Jackson Middle Schools offer Pre-AICE courses. Students who earn an AICE Diploma and complete the required number of community service hours qualify for the full Bright Futures Scholarship. Funding for this program is through FTE as stated in Florida Statute 1011.62. Please see attached document for current pricing.

CONTRACT TERM:

The initial contract term shall commence November 23, 2022 and continue until November 22, 2023.
