In Progress - Ongoing

E-Course: *Conscious Discipline-Building Resilient Schools and Homes*

This course equips adults with a foundational understanding of supports and strategies that create safe, connected, and problem-solving environments that allow adults and kids to function in their optimal brain state.

- Package purchased November 4, 2022 – provides access to content for one year (through November 4, 2023)
- 10 session self-paced online course
- Offered to all BPS schools and Charter Schools
- 132 participants currently registered
- Upon completion, 12 Students with Disabilities professional development credits awarded (continuing education for professional certification)
- Participants have access to content until 11/4/2023
- Fully paid. No refund option.

In Progress - Paused

- Schools planned to attend Orlando conference in June
 - 5 schools (Creel, Croton, Discovery, Mims, Sabal)
 - Planned expenditure - \$72,753 – registration and travel
 - Partially paid (registrations & reservations) but can be cancelled
- Planned on-site and virtual coaching sessions
 - 15 sites
 - Most sessions scheduled for May; few happened in April
 - Planned expenditure - \$25,380
 - Can cancel future sessions; pay for services rendered
- PreK-VE – ESE Summer Training
 - Planned training \$3,870
 - Previously purchased and received
 - 45 Self-Regulation Kits \$17,595; 6 more on order
 - Not yet deployed

Funding

- Title IV funds (\$240,000) reallocated (via program amendment) to:
 - STEM and robotics equipment
 - Laptops, iPads and iPad carts to support technology integration in the classroom
 - Updating middle school CTE computer labs

Looking Ahead

- Following Board guidance on 4/25:
 - Can sunset conscious discipline model
 - Some tools are already deployed in schools and may still be used
 - Cross-functional team can continue collaborative work to understand training needs and evolve training methods
 - Hybrid – in-house talent, contracted resources when larger scale needed
- Funding is still available for training
