PRICE INCREASE / DECREASE EXPLANATION: The District anticipates a 10% growth in the program based on previous years. There are no testing and course fee increases for FY20/21.

DISCUSSION:

The International Baccalaureate (IB) Program is an internationally recognized accelerated program in which students may earn college and university credits. The IB Program based in Geneva, Switzerland, serves schools in 146 countries. Students who receive a 4 or higher on a 7 point exam are awarded postsecondary credit. Each exam passed with a 4 or higher earns .16 FTE. Additionally, each student earning an IB Diploma also earns an extra .3 FTE. Add On FTE money earned from 2019-20 IB FTE totals \$314,260.00. Students who earn an IB Diploma and complete the required number of community service hours qualify for the Bright Futures Scholarship. Cocoa Beach Jr./Sr. High School and Melbourne High School offer the International Baccalaureate Program.

The standard bids waived template has been used, which does not require legal review.

CONTRACT TERM:

The contract term shall commence November 1, 2020 and continue until October 31, 2021.

RECOMMENDATION:

It is the recommendation of Dr. Stephanie Soliven, Assistant Superintendent of Secondary Leading & Learning, and Mollie Vega, Director of Secondary Leading & Learning, to award 21-204-BW-HD for International Baccalaureate in the amount of \$162,949.01.

- Assessment by an international team of examiners and moderators, overseen by independent chief examiners
- Clerical checking of assessment material to ensure administrative accuracy
- Where appropriate, access arrangements and consideration of individual special circumstances
- Access to results one day after results are released to schools
- A printed diploma, diploma results or certificate (depending on their results)
