As allowed per Florida Administrative Code 6A-1.012(5) and required by Section 1001.42(10)(j), F.S., the district school board shall receive and give consideration to the prices available to it under rules of the Department of Management Services, Division of Purchasing. District school boards may use prices established by the Division of Purchasing through the state purchasing agreement price schedule. If district school board policy provides for purchasing under this program of state purchasing agreements the conditions for use shall be those imposed on state agencies. The State of Florida Department of Management Services amended the contract to extend it by one (1) calendar year. Pricing has been established by the State of Florida Department of Management Services Contract # 25100000-19-1.

The standard state contract agenda template has been used, which does not require Legal review.

CONTRACT TERM:

The initial contract term commenced on April 15, 2020 and shall continue until November 16, 2021.
