Pricing based on Florida State Term Contract # 31160000-20-NASPO-ACS

State Board of Education Rule 6A-1.012 (5), the district school board shall receive and give consideration to the prices available to it under rules of the Department of Management Services, Division of Purchasing. District school boards may use prices established by the Division of Purchasing through its state purchasing agreement price schedule. If district school board policy provides for purchasing under this program of state purchasing agreements the conditions for use shall be those imposed on state agencies.

The contract term shall commence August 26, 2020 and continue until June 30, 2023.
