The Titusville High School NJROTC Orienteering Team Is requesting to send 5 cadets to the Georgia Orienteering Advance Training Camp (G.O.A.T.) This course is important in helping the team maintain its high level of performance. The team qualified for the 2022 Navy National Orienteering Championships and were the 2022 Varsity Orienteering State Champions. The camp will be held at Hard Labor Creek near Rutledge GA. From June 12th to June 17th 2022.

Educational Activity: Orienteering is a competitive sport that involves navigation over unfamiliar terrain with a map and compass. Orienteers use a myriad of problem solving skills and experience to choose the fastest route.

Transportation: Cadets will be transported using one rental van. Vans will be driven by the Senior Naval Science Instructor and one female Chaperone.

Lodging: Lodging will be in cabins at the camp.

Camp Fee:	\$325 Per cadet X 5 = \$1625. Includes food and lodging
Food:	During Transportation \$10 per person X 7 = \$70

Transportation: Approx: \$50 per day x 6 days = \$300
 Gas 20 mpg x \$4.00 x 1200 miles round trip + local= \$240

Total: \$2235
