COVID Guidance

- Vaccines are highly recommended for all of those who are eligible for them.
- Face coverings are optional, but strongly recommended; particularly for unvaccinated children and employees and especially when social distancing is not possible.
- It is strongly recommended all students riding a school bus wear a face covering.
- The current Florida Department of Health updated guidelines for quarantine protocols as of Friday, August 6, 2021, will be implemented for Brevard Public Schools' employees and students.
- Those showing symptoms should stay home.



COVID-Mitigation Strategies Summary



Continued Successful Strategies from 20-21 School Year

- Frequent handwashing and cleaning protocols should be utilized.
- Extraneous furniture and clutter will continue to be removed from classrooms **to allow for appropriate distancing.**
- Hallway traffic patterns will continue to be modified to minimize face-to-face interaction.
- Plexi-glass barriers may still be utilized in offices, reception areas, and classrooms.
- Water fountains will continue to be restricted to the filling of water bottles or cups.
- Clinic spaces will continue to allow for the separation of students.
- **Schools should continue to prioritize seating arrangements that minimize close student contact (utilizing CDC guidelines of 3 – 6 feet distancing);** however, flexible seating should be used when it benefits instruction.
