Subj : REQUEST APPROVAL FOR OUT OF STATE FIELD TRIP

The Titusville High School NJROTC Orienteering Team has qualified for the 2022 Navy National Orienteering Championships. In preparation for the Navy Nationals, the team will also participate in a two-day orienteering event sponsored by the Georgia Orienteering Club. The event will take place at the Red Top Mountain State Park, Ga 26-27 February.

**Educational Activity:** Cadets will expand their knowledge and understanding of the principles and tools of map reading and land navigation. Additionally, cadets will learn to interpret land features, such as mountains and valleys, depicted by contour lines on a topographic map. Cadets will have the opportunity to physically see and move along terrain features not normally found in Florida. Orienteering is a competitive sport that involves navigation over unfamiliar terrain with a map and compass. Orienteers use a myriad of problem-solving skills and experience to choose the fastest route.

**Transportation:** Cadets will be transported using two rental vans. Vans will be driven by school employees and registered volunteers with 5 cadets each as passengers.

**Lodging:** Lodging will be booked at a local motel near the competition. Cadets will sleep two to a room with one double bed each.


0600-0630 Reveille/morning routine

Cadets have conducted fundraisers to fund this trip.

Lodging: Approx: \$100 per night x 5 rooms x 2 nights = \$1000  
Food: Approx: \$20 per person x 3 days x 15 = \$900  
Transportation: Approx: \$75 per van x 3 days = \$450  
Gas 20 mpg x \$3.50 x 1200 miles round trip + local= \$420  
Competition entry fees: \$10 per cadet X 10 = \$100

Total: \$2870
